During the North Wexford Clean 2K volunteers picked 12Km of approach roads. A total of 170 bags of litter plus car tyres, car parts, electrical goods etc was collected. Rooted in the Community!

'Rooted in the Community' is a mosaic art project that involved the local Community Art Group. The mosaic design is based on a tree with its roots symbolically firmly rooted in the community of Ferns. The tree represents the tree of life, the tree of growth and of renewal. It's branches spread out along the wall as the local Community of Ferns reaches out from the village. As each branch uncurls at the end it reveals a symbol enclosed within the circle. Each symbol reflects the theme of Mary and the Marian shrine along-side garden themes emphasising Mary's link with nature. The art will celebrate the beauty of the garden and creation. It will make a beautiful addition to the Grotto project.
