This year we plan to enter the An Taisce National Spring Clean event and the North Wexford 2K clean. Litter picks will be organised for all the approach roads and the town starting in April. We are asking that all residents keep 200m of roadway at either side of their homes litter free. We would really appreciate your help. It's not an easy task but there is satisfaction when you see a nice litter free roads..

In 2017 volunteers picked 365 bags of litter from the 22km of approach roads. The highest percentage of this was from fly tipping and 90% of it was recyclable waste. We would ask that you please take home your litter and put it in your recycle bins.




Dates for your Diary!



Things you can Recycle At the Enniscorthy Recycle centre

- Newspapers etc
- Glass bottles
- Drink cans
- Tetra pack cartons
- Cardboard
- Plastics
- Textiles, curtains, Blankets, shoes
- All Metals
- Drink & Food Cans
- Batteries, car, and 3 eclectic fence
- Electrical goods, TV's, fridges, Cookers, tumble Dryers etc
- CD's & DVD'S For Oxfam
- Mobile Phones
- Waste cooking oil Max 23 Litres
- Printer cartridges
- Waste engine oil

Please remember to put out food and water for wildlife this winter

Seeds, suet and fat balls will help lots of birds whilst mammals, such as hedgehogs and foxes, will eat tinned dog food and meaty cat biscuits.

Don't forget about fresh water each day too!

Tip: putting a football in a pond will keep an area free from ice.

Confused about what to put into your recycling bin...?

So what can be recycled? Everything that is plastic, aluminium, paper or cardboard – provided it is clean! This includes:

1. PET – plastic drinks bottles and much of our food packaging
2. LDPE – Low density polyethylene (e.g. sandwich bag)
3. HDPE – High density polyethylene (e.g. shampoo bottle)
4. Clean and dry paper and cardboard, 5. Aluminium cans

In a nutshell? Only put clean, dry and loose material into your recycling bin. Don't put plastic bags in the recycling bin, but better yet, avoid using them altogether!
